The Coordinator completed the **Certified Sexual Health Educator (C-SHE) Program** in 2015, and was re-certified in 2017. The Program, offered by EyesOpenIowa, aligns with the **National Preparation Standards for Sexual Health created by Future of Sex Education Initiative (FoSE)**. The

certification allows the CAPP Coordinator to:

-  Demonstrate professionalism, knowledge, and comfort when **teaching sexual health education**.
-  **Promote respect** for individuals, families and cultures when teaching sexual health education.
-  Provide education in a manner that is **age-appropriate, medically accurate, and factual**.
-  Establish a basic set of **ethical practices**.
-  Promote delivery of material that is age and developmentally appropriate, & that aligns with the **Iowa Human Growth and Development Mandate**.
-  Implement a variety of **teaching strategies** when teaching sexual health education.
-  Acquire skills to **self-assess and self-evaluate students' knowledge** to better improve sexual health education.
